
## WARNING — TO REDUCE THE RISK OF BURNS, ELECTROCUTION, FIRE, OR INJURY TO PERSONS:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- To protect against electrical hazards, do not use while bathing or in the shower.
- 3. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children or by invalids.
- 4. Do not operate this appliance if the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner. Return appliance to nearest service facility for examination, electrical or mechanical adjustment, or repair. No repairs should be attempted by the consumer.

- 10.Do not place or store appliance where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
- 11.Do not place in or drop into water or other liquid.
- 12.If appliance gets submersed in water, remove safely. If unit is in the "I" (ON) position turn the unit to the "0" (OFF) position immediately.

# SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Your lighted makeup mirror is 5.75 in. diameter with 5X and 1X magnification. (Fig. 1)
- This unit operates on 3 "AA" batteries (not included). Turn switch to the "I" (ON) position.
- 3. After use, always turn switch to the "0" (OFF) position.
- The beauty and design of this mirror complement any decor. Therefore, you may wish to leave the mirror displayed. However, if you choose to store the mirror, see "STORAGE" for detailed information.



## TO REPLACE BULB


CAUTION: TURN OFF POWER. ALLOW TO COOL AT LEAST 3 MINUTES BEFORE REPLACING BULB.

NOTE: Do not use bulbs other than those supplied by Conair. Contact a Conair service center for replacement bulb information.

- Unscrew the two side screws on the mirror head.
- Carefully remove the 1X Magnification mirror head housing.
- Unscrew light bulb and replace with new light bulb.
- Replace mirror head by lining up the screw holes and screw into place.

## TO INSTALL BATTERIES

- 1. Remove battery cover.
- 2. Install 3 "AA" new batteries as indicated on battery box. (Fig. 2)
- 3. Replace battery cover by snapping it into place.

### MAINTENANCE

Your lighted mirror is designed for household use and is virtually maintenance-free. No lubrication is needed.

If cleaning becomes necessary, disconnect the appliance from the power source and wipe exterior with a damp cloth. Clean mirror surfaces with a glass cleaner. Do not light until you are certain mirror is completely dry.

If any abnormal condition occurs, turn it off, allow it to cool, and return it to an authorized service center for repair.

## **STORAGE**

BE SURE DIRECT SUNLIGHT DOES NOT STRIKE MAGNIFYING SIDE OF MIRROR WHEN LEFT UNATTENDED. Allow to cool to room temperature before storing. Place in cool, dry area out of reach of children, where it will not be damaged.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING BATTERIES

- Always purchase the correct size and grade of battery most suitable for the intended use.
- Replace old batteries of a set at the same time.
- Do not mix old and new batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel cadmium) batteries.
- Clean the battery compartment by blowing away any debris prior to battery installation.
- Ensure the batteries are installed correctly with regard to polarity (+ and -).
- Remove batteries from equipment that will not be used for an extended period of time.
- . When batteries begin to fail, remove promptly.

## **BATTERY DISPOSAL**

Batteries contain various materials that must be recycled and disposed of properly. Do not dispose in the municipal waste system.

## LIMITED ONE YEAR WARRANTY

Conair will repair or replace (at our option) your unit free of charge for 12 months from the date of purchase if the appliance is defective in workmanship or materials.

To obtain service under this warranty, return the defective product to the service centre listed below, together with your purchase receipt and \$7.50 for postage and handling. In the absence of a purchase receipt, the warranty period shall be 12 months from the date of manufacture.
